Dominique Lévy, co-founder and partner of Lévy Gorvy gallery

'This will be my 10th year showing at the fair, and I'll be at the <u>Lévy Gorvy booth (E6)</u> showing works by Chuck Close, Robert Motherwell, François Morellet and more. I am certainly hoping to find time to visit the new ICA building too — it's a must-see, with an incredible exhibition program, including *The Everywhere Studio* (see above) and also the first ever museum presentation of <u>Wet Night Early Dawn</u>, the historic series by Senga Nengudi.



Domique Lêvy recommends the Argentine tenderloin at Los Fuegos at the Faena

'Dine at <u>Casa Tua</u>, which is right on Miami Beach. <u>Los Fuegos at the Faena</u> is also exceptional — make sure to try the Argentine tenderloin. Often I stay with friends in Miami, but if not, the <u>Faena Hotel</u> is beautiful. I recommend visitors find a place right in the heart of the action, which is to say in Miami Beach. For me, it's best to be right near the fair.
